The general body elects the Governing Body.

The Executive Director is the Project Director for all Projects under the NEED organisation, the Programme Manager is ruted by the Director in Planning, Implementation and Monitoring the activities, the Manager is implementing the Projects and programmes with the collaboration of Project Coordinators and coordinators and field level staff members at the Mandal and District level.
